Therefore, we require and expect a Core Group Leader to be a person who:

1. Personal Soundness
 - a. Speaks well of others
 - b. Is willing to face issues
 - c. Follows through with responsibilities and commitments
 - d. Manages time well
 - e. Is willing to lovingly & directly confront others when necessary
 - f. Actively affirms others
 - g. Has strong biblical values that don’t change easily
 - h. Is teachable

2. Chi Alpha Involvement
 - a. Attends Tuesday night “XA2” meetings consistently and includes others
 - b. Participates fully in core group activities
 - c. Attends **PREP, Fall Breakaway & SALT**, and has attended the **LTC** (**CAST** is also highly recommended)
 - d. Actively engages in weekly Leadership Resource Team lunches
 - e. Is willing to serve the Chi Alpha family in whatever is helpful
 - f. Thinks of/ Invents ways to grow, bless, and/or serve the group





- i. Serving in roles outside of core group (not required but encouraged)
 - g. Prays out loud in group settings
- 3. Jesus-World Overlap
 - a. Maintains a good reputation with those inside and outside XA
 - i. Includes: Those outside your circle of friends, professors, classmates, roommates and floormates, RA's, parents, and employers
 - b. Maintains a morally appropriate and honorable digital & online presence
 - i. This includes but is not limited to: Facebook, Twitter, Snapchat, YouTube, Vine, Instagram, as well as text messages, email, and offline applications (such as desktop backgrounds or "screen savers")
 - c. Has values and morals that don't change around others ("two-faced"/ "dual lifestyle")
 - d. Recognizes and meets needs of those who won't or can't reciprocate as well as those who can
 - e. Agrees to abstain from sexual activity
 - f. Agrees to abstain from drugs and alcohol
- 4. Relationship With Jesus
 - a. Has been following Jesus for at least a year
 - b. Consistently sets aside time to read the Bible, pray, and abide in Jesus' presence
 - c. Exhibits a desire and hunger for the things of God
 - d. Is confessional and responsive to God
 - e. Loves Jesus
 - f. Displays a GROWING relationship with Jesus
